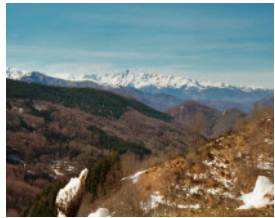


What to do in the Area



Carcassonne in November

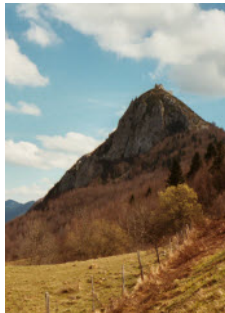

The Pyrenees

The flat plains, hills and mountains provide an enormous variety of terrain for walkers, cyclists and mountain bikers of all levels. Spring and autumn are ideal seasons with sunny days and cooler temperatures.

Visit the ruins of Cathar settlements like Montsegur, Queribus and Puylaurens, or stroll through the narrow-streets of a medieval hill-top village and pause in the square to watch a game of petanque.



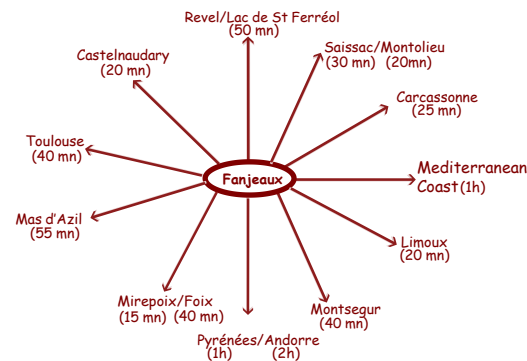
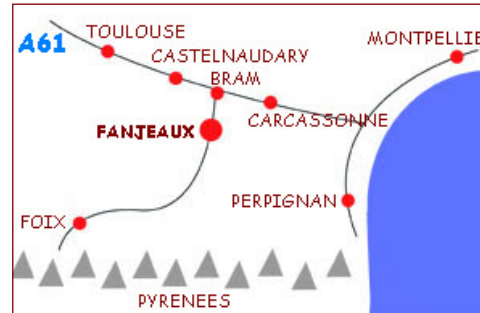

You can also take the Motorail to Narbonne & Toulouse, or there are low cost flights from the UK and Ireland to Carcassonne, Perpignan, Beziers and Toulouse.

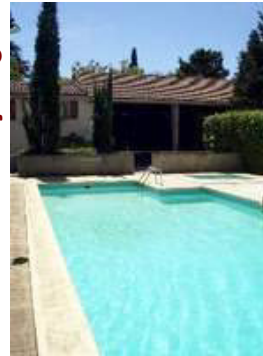
La Chevaline

The Gites

Each gite has its own garden area, equipped with garden furniture and barbeque. The gites all have a well-equipped kitchen which contains a cooker, dishwasher, washing machine, fridge freezer, filter coffee maker and toaster. The living rooms are equipped with a CD/Radio/Cassette player and sofas or easy chairs. There is a hairdryer in each cottage. Rental prices include household linen and utilities, but not pool towels which are available on request.
